Who Are We

- A UK teaching hospital with a workforce of 5,500 delivering acute healthcare services to a population of 400,000
- Here we present our experiences of delivering the Clinical Librarian service in Anaesthetics & Critical Care

Clinical Activity

- Clinical Librarian attends Intensive Care ward round
- Searches for best evidence on patient conditions and treatment at the bedside
- Demonstrates a positive impact on patient care



A Clinical Librarian in an acute hospital setting enhances evidence based practice by providing the right information, in the right place, at the right time.

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What is a Clinical Librarian?

- A qualified and specialised librarian
- Works in hospital alongside doctors, nurses & healthcare professionals
- Searches for evidence (guidelines, research studies, publications) to enhance patient care
- Provides training and expertise to enhance clinical decision making



Research and Audit

- Clinical Librarian facilitates critical appraisal workshops
- Develops robust search strategies for database searches (e.g. PubMed, Medline & Embase)
- Helps to close the gap between research and practice



Professional Development & Training

- Clinical Librarian attends continuing medical journal CMO 3-weeks with preceptors to select a research study and clinically appraise it
- Provides one-to-one training on searching for journal articles, guidelines and publications
