Dementia

▶ What is it

- Dementia is a word used to describe a group of symptoms including memory loss, confusion, mood changes and difficulty with day-to-day tasks.
- Dementia itself is not a disease – its actually caused by lots of different diseases
- Dementia has a bigger impact on women – as women live longer, well into their 80s, half a million women in the UK are living with dementia. The condition is the leading cause of death in women in the UK. Women also are more likely to take on the unpaid caring roles.
