









The Change Curve







CILIP Research & Evidence Base – Next steps

Now that we have clear evidence of sector demand for a Research and Evidence Base, CILIP is moving forward with three connected actions:

- 1. The establishment of a **Research Coalition**, bringing together academics and employers to develop a common **Research**Framework
- 2. Fundraising for a **pilot initiative** to develop 'test cases' small Evidence Bases to address specific sector needs
- 3. Exploring practical **long-term solutions** to making research and evidence more accessible using existing infrastructure

We have launched a comprehensive new online and face-to-face learning and CPD programme, featuring content and e-learning to help librarians and information professionals keep their skills up-to-date.






Chartered Knowledge Managers

In April, CILIP is launching Professional Registration for the global Knowledge Management community, coinciding with the publication of the ISO30401:2018 Standard.

For the first time, we will be able to accredit KM professionals as "Chartered Knowledge Managers".


