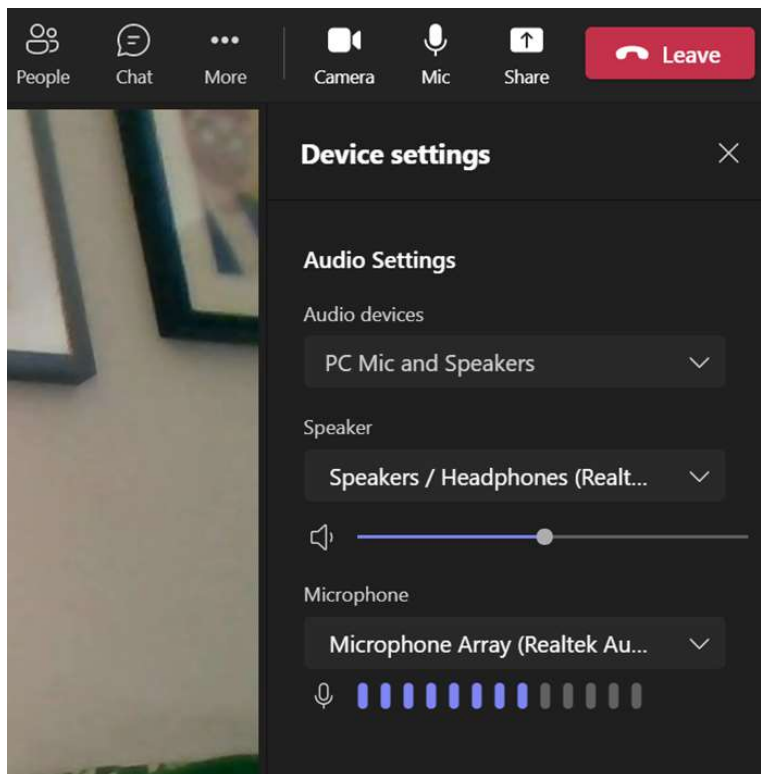
### **Solving the tech problems that we had with MS Teams**
