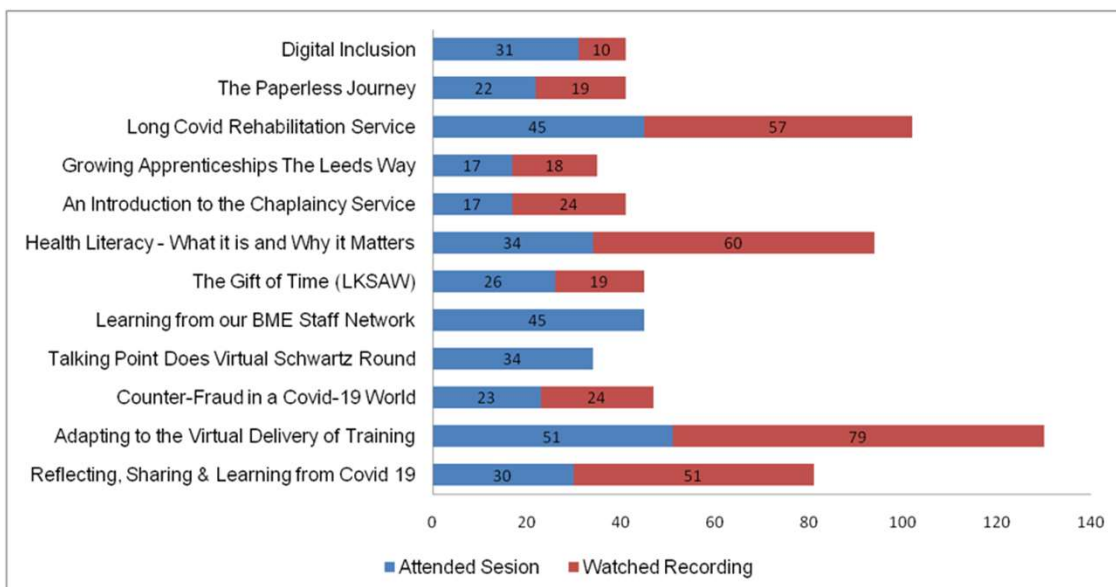



It was really good and really informative. I've talked to a lot of people afterwards about the things I learnt from this talk.

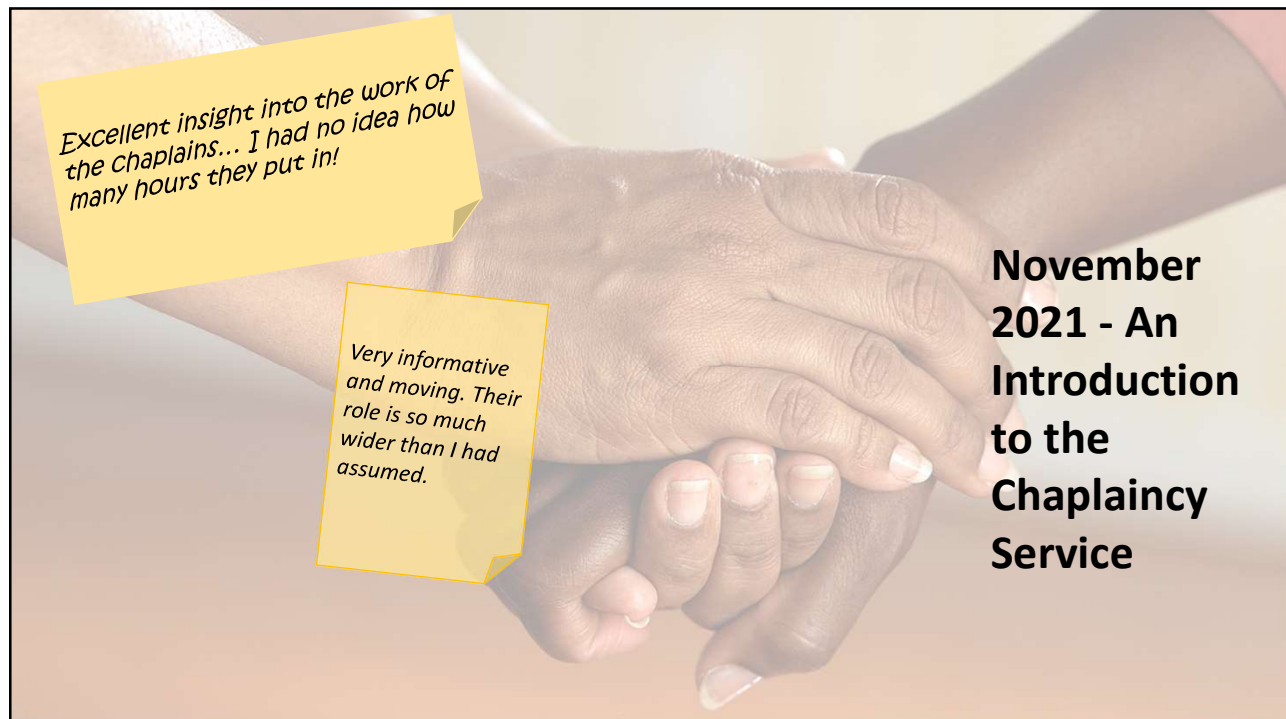
